Apple American Mother MM106-euro 26.95-soft,sweet,juicy and aromatic.Scab resistant,likes full sun.Pollinators: Braeburn, Ellisons Orange, Lord Derby.

Apple Arthur Turner MM106-EURO 26.95-outstanding pink blossom in Spring,cooking apple.Pollinators:Discovery, Coxs Orange Pippin,

Apple Ellisons Orange MM 106-Euro 26.95,green to yellow,Fruits are very juicy with an aniseed flavour if picked late.

A hardy variety with good scab and frost resistance.Picking time-mid-September

Apple Irish Peach MM106-EURO 26.95-raised in Ireland ,an early,high quality dessert variety.Flesh is tender,pale&aromatic.

Pick-early August. Pollinators: Beauty of Bath.

Apple Newton Wonder MM106-euro 22.95-well known cooking apple.Recommended for its its heavy yields of fine flavoured fruits.Picking time-Mid-October

Apple Sunset M27-euro 22.95-fruits are gold with red stripes.Crisp,fine textured flesh with good aromatic Cox-like flavour,which is sharp and intense.Picking time-late September.

Apple Worcester Pearmain M26-euro

22.95,harvest:September.Pollinators:Sunset,Queen Cox,James Grieve,Grenadier,Arthur Turner,Charles Ross,Coxs Orange Pippin,Discovery.

Apricot/Nectarine/Peach

Dwarf Nectarine Nectarella euro 33.80

Nectarine Fantasia St.Julien A euro 27.25-large yellow fruits with firm and smooth red skin.Height when mature:3-4 metres.

Peach Rochester St.Julien A EURO 27.25-firm and juicy flesh,protect from winter rainfall to control leaf curl.Self fertile but hand pollination is advantageous .

Apricot Tomcot euro 29.95- gives a very heavy crop of large crimson,flushed fruits.Mature height:3 metres.

Asparagus

Connovers Colossal euro 4.99 likes well drained soil or a raised bed.Harvest mid-May to Mid-June.

Gijnlim F1 euro 4.99-heavy yielding,thick spears,heavy crops of medium to thick spears

Purple Passion euro 4.99-

Backlim F1 euro 4.99-thick,smooth spears,mid-late production.,harvest two years after planting crowns.

Theilim euro 4.99-early production with good yields producing thick spears of good quality.

Berries

Buckingham Tayberry-thornless –euro 9.95

Tayberry euro 9.95

Currants

Blackcurrant Robusta Half Standard-euro 29.95-large fruits and very heavy yields.Support main stem with a strong robust stake and tie in securely.Stakes and ties available at Hosfords.

Blackcurrant Ben Connan euro 8.50-high yields of exceptionally large fruit.Resistant to mildew and leaf curling midge.plant 1m apart.

Blackcurrant Ben Lomond euro 8.50-flowers and fruits late so miss the frosts,large sweet berry,mildew resistant,plant 1 metre apart.

Redcurrant Rovada half/standard euro 29.95 high yields of very large fruits,flavour is good and juicy.plant 1 metre apart.Support with a permanent robust stake.

Redcurrant Red Lake euro 8.50 reliable variety,large fruits with heavy yields.

Whitecurrant White Versailles euro 8.50-very reliable giving good crops every year.

Gooseberries

Hinnomaki Red euro 9.50-heavy cropper with mildew resistance.

Hinnomaki yellow euro 9.50-very large yellow fruit,excellent flavour,good mildew resistance-pick mid-July,plant 1.5 metres apart.

Hinnomaki green euro 9.50 –excellent flavour,good mildew resistance-plant 1.5m apart.

Pax euro 9.50-large red fruit,virtually spineless.Mildew resistance is very high-plant 1.25m.apart.

Grape

Black Hamburgh euro 11.50-good flavour for glasshouse growing.Glasshouses/polytunnels available from Hosfords.

Plum

Victoria Euro 25.00 ST.Julien A.

Raspberries euro 3.99 per pot of 2.

Glen Ample –mid-season,July Award of Garden Merit,The Royal Horticultural Society-plant 18” apart.

Glen Clova –ideal for freezing,maturing early July.

Heritage-Autumn Fruiting.

Leo-this is the last to mature in the summer fruiting raspberries,The taste is good and quite tangy.Texture is firm and growth is vigorous.Has aphid resistance.A very good garden variety.

Glen Moy-large berries,good aphid resistance and a small Autumn crop in warm summers.Good yielding variety,picking time-early July.

Glen Prosen- fruit round and very firm,flavour is good and there is some resistance to aphid and virus.Heavy cropping.

Tulameen

Malling Jewel-extremely high yields.Large good quality fruits in excess of 4g. each.Picking time-Late July-early August. Good botrytis resistance.

Octavia- fruiting mid-July-early August,produces large and juicy fruit in profusion,all with a delightfully sweet flavour

Strawberries euro 2.50 each.

Calypso,firm,regular,attractive fruit,glossy orange red with an attractive flavour.

Elsanta –high yields,attractive glossy fruit,outstanding flavour.

Symphony-bright glossy fruit in mid-July.

Sonata-New!* good fruit size,firmness of berries excellent,one or two days later than Elsanta.

Albion-ever bearer –the plant health of Albion is so good that along with its excellent flavour,it is now the number one variety grown by leading organic strawberry growers.The fruit is typically long,conical and very symmetrical.
